


TOUCH OF METAL TEXTURES/FINISHES

'Finish' is defined quality of the surface of an object – how it looks.





Whether it is jewellery, textile, furniture, fashion or visual arts .Motifs means a design that consists of recurring shapes/colors. **Traditional** Motif has always been a driving force in Indian jewellery design. These natural motifs have been taken from nature and surrounding environment.



Gemstones are called as precious stones, most of them are hard but few soft minerals with cut and polished form are used in jewellery.

It is a piece of mineral, which are grouped into precious and semi-precious stones including both uncut and faceted stones.

SOUTH SEA PEARLS-

South sea pearls are the largest type of cultured pearls.

Each pearl is grown in the oyster for 2-3 years and should have a soft silky lustre. The South sea pearl is bead-nucleated and is usually round/symmetrical in shape.

TAHITIAN PEARLS:

Tahitian pearl is an organic gem formed from the black-lip oyster (pinctada margaritifera). These pearls come in range of colors from white to black. Tahitian pearl is also known as black pearl.

















COMPASSION OF PINK TOURMALINE






KADA









CHANDELIER EARRINGS
